



## **EBORACUM MOTORCYCLE CLUB OF YORK**

### **The Club Rules Passed A.G.M 1983, 1989, adjusted 1992, 1994, 1997, 1998, 2000, 2009 and 2011, 2022**

1. The name of the Club shall be Eboracum Motorcycle Club of York.
2. The Club shall be affiliated to the A.C.U through the East Yorks Centre.
3. The purpose of the Club is to further and encourage motorcycling/sport within the Club and its members, to arrange competitions, club runs, social events, etc.
4. The officials of the Club shall consist of: Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, plus assistant Secretaries as required.
5. Officials will be elected for 1 year at the A.G.M. These officials will constitute the Club Management Committee.
6. All Club members are entitled to vote. Club officials to be elected by a simple majority at the AGM. All ties to be decided by the Chair.
7. An annual subscription to be paid for membership from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December. Any member whose subscription is unpaid by 1<sup>st</sup> January shall automatically cease to be a member.
8. The Club reserves the right to refuse membership without stating any reason.
9. Every member shall abide by all rules and regulations of the Club and the A.C.U.
10. A General Meeting shall be held annually in December. A special General Meeting may be held at the written request of 10 members, with the secretary giving 1 week's notice of same. A deposit of £50.00 shall accompany any such request and should this meeting decide the business to be of a frivolous nature, the deposit shall be forfeited. Only the business for which a special General Meeting has been convened may be dealt with on that occasion.
11. The financial year of the Club shall run from 1<sup>st</sup> November to the 31<sup>st</sup> October.
12. All alterations to the Club rules must be made at the A.G.M or at an Extraordinary General Meeting.
13. The Club Management Committee shall have the power to expel or otherwise deal with any member guilty of conduct deemed detrimental to the Eboracum Motorcycle Club of York.
14. The Club Management Committee shall have the power to make by-law and to settle all disputes not covered by these rules, such decisions to be ratified at the next A.G.M.
15. Management Committee meetings will need 3 elected officers to form a quorum. A.G.M will need 7 Club members to form a quorum. Any meeting once commenced shall not be adjourned for want of a quorum.
16. All competitions shall be run in accordance with the N.S.C of the A.C.U and East Yorks Centre, and any supplementary Regulations that may be necessary.
17. No politics or religion to be discussed at meetings or any events.
18. All questions and remarks at meetings must be addressed to the Chairman.
19. In the event of the Club's winding up all Club assets will be donated to the ACU Benevolent Fund.
